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ACCOMPANYING DOCUMENTS

- A Resume (including all relevant third sector experience)
- The Applicant's Personal Statement (one page maximum)
- A copy of documentation on the training or educational course which includes the name of the academic institution or other organization hosting the course and the cost of tuition.

APPLICANTS PURSUING A COLLEGE DEGREE OR CERTIFICATE

Applicants who are pursuing a college degree or certificate should **also** include the following:

- High school transcript, or academic transcripts of all undergraduate and graduate coursework, Graduate Record Examination scores (if applying for financial support to complete a degree);
- Documentation that the applicant has been accepted for admission.
- A letter of recommendation regarding the applicant's academic history
- A detailed budget including room and board, transportation and other related expenses.

The Scholarship Committee will review all applications and short-listed applicants may be invited to an interview. At this point, applicants may be requested to provide the following additional documentation:

- A birth certificate.
- A certificate or other document from the Department of Immigration demonstrating the status of the applicant (Bermudian, spouse of Bermudian, work permit holder, etc.).
- A certificate of good health from a registered doctor.
- A recent full-face photograph of the applicant.
