### Promoting Volunteerism

- **Community Days** - Members are eligible to participate in island-wide Community Days that offer corporate teams the opportunity to work on a rewarding one-day or half-day volunteer project. Offered in the Fall, Spring and Summer.
- **Holiday Cheer Initiative** - an opportunity for companies to engage their employees in community giving during the holiday season. The Centre on Philanthropy coordinates the creation and giving of personalized cards and gifts between our non-profit members (for the constituents that they serve) and our corporate membership.
